

Paid Internship Specification June 2018

Role title: STEM intern

Objectives of the role

- The internship position is designed to support schools in their provision of Maths and Physics subject specialist teaching by encouraging STEM specialists to work in secondary schools across the Birmingham area.
- There will be a strong training element to the role in order to support interns to be effective in Maths and Physics teaching during the placement

During the school-based placements, interns will be expected to:

- Attend 4 days of training and professional development
- Actively participate in training activities
- Attend a school based placement for 16 days
- Act in accordance with safeguarding guidance
- Follow the timetable of activities provided by the placement school
- Use subject knowledge to work with students in small groups or 1-2-1 and support their Maths and/or Physics development
- Act in a professional manner at all times
- Complete your journal of evidence regularly and completely
- Engage in review and reflection on your internship performance

Interns will receive £300 per week, on condition of full time programme attendance.

Internships will be based in one of a designated number of Birmingham-based schools. The 4 training days will be based at Bishop Challoner TSA.



Person Specification for Paid Internship, Summer 2018

The successful candidate must:

- Currently be studying a Maths or Physics related degree
- Be expecting to graduate in July 2019
- Be available to attend an internship for 20 days starting on 18th June 2018
- Be able to provide own transport to a school in the Birmingham area
- Be punctual
- Attend the full school hours specified by your placement school
- Be smart and professional in dress

The successful candidate should:

- Work well in a team
- Be confident in speaking to others
- Be positive in the face of challenges
- Be able to explain Maths and/or Physics concepts clearly
- Be passionate about the study of Maths and/or Physics
- Be open to feedback
- Be resilient
